

JOHN 15: ²⁶“When the Advocate comes, (1) whom I will send to you from the Father, (2) the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, (3) he will testify on my behalf. ²⁷You also are to testify because you have been with me from the beginning.”

New Revised Standard Version

1. Jesus will send the Advocate from the Father
2. he is the Spirit of truth
3. he will testify on Jesus' behalf

So now we understand that the Holy Spirit is...

1. another Advocate
2. he will be with us forever
3. he is knowable
4. he abides with us
5. and is in us
6. sent in Jesus' name
7. he will teach us everything
8. he will remind us of Jesus' teaching
9. Jesus will send the Advocate from the Father
10. he is the Spirit of truth
11. he will testify on Jesus' behalf
